

How to weave an 8 pointed star

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1. Take 4 equal lengths of ribbon and fold them in half.

These strands are 48cm long x 3cm wide.

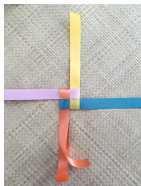


2. Slide one folded strand (blue) over the left folded strand (orange).

Pull the blue strand down about 10cm.



3. Wrap the 3rd (yellow) strand around the blue horizontal strand. Ensure the fold of the yellow ribbon is at the bottom.



4. Wrap the 4th (pink) strand around the yellow strand and insert both pink ends through the orange loop. Pull pink strands all the way to left.



5. Flip your woven cross over and fold top left (orange) strand down and crease.



6. Going anti-clockwise, fold one strand on the left (pink) over to the right and crease.



7. Continue next with one yellow folding up and then the blue over to the left and under the orange.



8. Make your first point with top right strand. Fold under to the right and crease.



9. Fold forward and down to make a larger triangle & crease.



10. Fold larger triangle in half then thread through blue pocket and trim.



11. Repeat these points on every second strand til you have 4 points on this side.



12. Now flip your star over and complete the last 4 points on this side (steps 8-10).



13. Well done! You just wove an 8 pointed star!



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
